**INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN ELECTRONIC AUCTIONING FOR  
ALLOCATING HUNTING BLOCKS IN TANZANIA**

(Made under regulation 8 of the Wildlife Conservation [Hunting Tourism] Regulations, 2024)

Tanzania Wildlife Management Authority (TAWA) invites applications from eligible applicants to participate in an e-Auction for hunting blocks to be conducted from 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2024 running for 24 hours daily. The e-Auction is being held for the purpose of allocating hunting blocks to hunting companies. It will involve a total of **07** hunting blocks: One (**01**) hunting block in Category I, five (**05**) hunting blocks in Category II and one (**01**) hunting block in Category III. The Minister will issue certificates of hunting block allocation to successive bidders for periods of 10 years for hunting blocks in Categories I and II and 15 years for hunting blocks in Category III. Eligible hunting companies can be allocated up to five (5) hunting blocks each, which shall be of different categories.

**Applicants are strongly advised to visit and inspect the hunting blocks that they intend to bid prior the bidding process. Auctioning will commence at 00:00hrs on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2024 and will last for seven consecutive days until 23:59:59hrs on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2024.**

**1. QUALIFICATIONS FOR BIDDERS**

According to the Wildlife Conservation Cap. 283, no person shall be considered for allocation of a hunting block unless:

- (a) He has a company registered with the Registrar of Companies within Tanzania intending to engage in hunting of animals;
- (b) Is willing to form and register a hunting company in Tanzania within two months following winning at the e-auction;
- (c) A company has at least one Senior Staff in managerial position with knowledge and three (3) years' experience in Wildlife Conservation in Tanzania; and
- (d) A participating company must have a Tanzanian among its shareholders with not less than ten percent of subscribed shares;

- (e) Business plan showing business details, service structure, capital, target customers, markets, financial analysis and revenue expectations;

## 2. HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE E-AUCTION

- a) Applicants will register online at <http://portal.maliasili.go.tz> through the appropriate e-form provided.
- b) After successful registration an applicant will be assigned an auto generated username and password sent via their registered e-mail addresses
- c) The username and password will enable participants access the bidding dashboard and bid anonymously according to the information specified on the bidding interface.
- d) Upon accessing the bidding dashboard, applicants will select category and hunting blocks they intend to bid on and the system will automatically generate an e-invoice for the applicant to pay a non- refundable application fee as per rates shown below:

- e) After payment has been registered applicants can start bidding
- f) Bids will be automatically ranked, the contents of which will be encrypted.

## 3. HOW TO BID

- a) Bidders may log in and out of the e-auction system as many times as they wish during the e-auction period,
- b) Bidders will be notified automatically of the proceeding bids on the hunting blocks individuals are bidding on,
- c) A bidder shall remain anonymous to other bidders in the course of auctioning,
- d) An invalid bid shall be rejected by the system and a message explaining reasons for rejection will appear,
- e) Bidders shall not provide any additional information or clarifications related to the auction that may distort competition; and where necessary, such information shall be availed by TAWA,
- f) Bidders shall be responsible for maintaining confidentiality of all particulars associated with their accounts,

- g) An e-auction award shall be based solely on ranking of prices, such that the allocation is awarded to the highest successful bidder as registered on MNRT Portal (e-auction module),
- h) No bid may be withdrawn after closure of e-auction,
- i) Bidders will only be allowed to increase their bid prices during the auctioning process,
- j) A bidder will be declared winner if their bid is registered in the system as higher than current bid,
- k) A winner of a hunting block shall pay 25% of the winning price within two working days after closure of the e-auction,
- l) The winner will be given an award letter with conditions to pay the remaining seventy-five percent within fourteen days from the date of the letter
- m) A winning price shall constitute a hunting block fee to be paid annually from the date of the certificate of hunting block allocation issued by the Minister,
- n) During bidding, bidders shall be prompted by an auto generated message to re-confirm their placed bids once by keying in the bid figure again.
